Food Pantry Report

April 2024

At the April food distribution, 68 households representing 175 individuals were served. During the first four months of 2024, the Food Pantry has served 298 households representing 850 individuals; during the first four months of 2023, 282 households representing 746 individuals were served. The next food distribution is Friday, May 10th.

SMCC has received a \$5,000 grant from First Bank to buy food for the Food Pantry. This donation is part of the Power of Good grants program that FB began this year. The Food Pantry is grateful for this generous donation which will help ensure that our neighbors have nutritious food during the next year and beyond.
